Type of frames acceptable

If you have frames, you are encouraged. Clip Frames. Low cost glass frames that can support matted or non matted photos.

Foam Core board. Relatively low mount cost

Canvas wrapped art

Backer board. Harder variety of Foam Core Board.

Will there be a fee to show?

Other than a possible commission, there will be no hanging fees.

Hanger types required

The frames must be sturdy, and all frames must have a wire type hanger. Z hooks or clip hangers will not be hung. A separate site will show how to add wires to clip frames or foam core boards. The hanging wires cannot be exposed. (I.E. They cannot be seen when the art is hung.) Please note that wire MUST be on all frames. Yarn or string may not be used.

Print sizes allowed

The exhibit will be limited to prints/paintings no larger than 48 inches x 72 inches. Smaller frames are, of course, welcome.

Subject matter allowed

The subject matter cannot contain any nudity, overt political subject matter, and must be family friendly. The owners will have final say on the objects shown. There will be no jury to accept your art.

How many items can I display

There is plenty of space, but dependent on how many participate, we may limit the entries to 10. Please send me the quantity early so I can get a handle on the amounts.

We will be showing starting Saturday, November 1st, 2014 through Wednesday, December 31st, 2014.

What do I need to send in and when

I will be making up the Artists display cards so that we have a common look and feel. The cards will have the following information:

When will our art be hung?

As we get closer to the show, I will schedule a two hour window to accommodate the hanging, and not disturb the patrons. You do need to be present at the hanging. No art will be hung after that time. The art must be hung on standard J hooks you supply. Any Artists cards or bio's must be hung using UHU putty to not disturb the walls.

When will can I pickup my art?

Art needs to be taken down the last two days of the show, unless sold. Please pick them up between 2:00 PM and 6:00 PM at Capitol Community Cable Television (CCTV) . Though I am always present at hanging time, I may or may not be there during pick up time. Make sure you bring proper identification.

Where and when will I deliver my art?

Right now, I won't be taking any art in at my house. All art must be hung by the Artist at the site. **See the When will our art be hung?** topic.

When will get paid for any art that is sold?

All sales transactions must occur between you and the buyer. Capitol Community Cable Television (CCTV) will not collect funds.
